

MOTORCYCLE TRACK DAY RULES

Online Bookings

Due to the large group sizes, it is important that bookings are made online at www.dubaiautodrome.com

Briefing - Compulsory

For everyone's safety, all participants are required to attend the official briefing before the track day. If anyone misses or is late for the briefing, they unfortunately will not be permitted to take part in the track day, regardless of how many previous track days sessions they have participated in.

Busy Track Days

In case of groups being full, online bookings will be given priority, regardless of the rider's experience or frequency of attendance.

Advanced Group

Current or previous race license holders are automatically certified to take part in the Advanced Group.

On-the-day competency assessments will be made available by an official track day instructor if any Intermediate rider feels their experience level is adequate for the Advanced Group. These assessments will take place in the Intermediate Group only.

Should the assessment be passed, you will be eligible to book only in the Advanced Group starting from the next official track day. Changes of group on the day will not be allowed.

Intermediate Group

This group is for non-race license holders and riders who are not novices. This rider should be comfortable in large groups, be lapping safely and consistently. They should not be a hindrance to themselves and others.

***Please note:** In the case of the Intermediate Group being full, kindly refrain from booking yourself in the Advanced Group. You will unfortunately not be eligible to take part if you have not passed the Advanced Group assessment.

Novice group

For riders who are new to circuit riding and would like to improve their riding skills. Overtaking is only allowed on the straight in a bid to help riders enjoy a pressure free ride. Private Tuition is unfortunately not permitted in this group.

Important Notes on Health and Safety:

Each group will be appointed official Track Day Instructors. Their role is to monitor each and every rider on the day in a bid to ensure all riders are in the correct group and are riding safely and to their abilities.

►Dubai Autodrome Race Control and official Track Day instructors will be forced to remove anyone from the session if they do not follow basic track rules and discipline or if they are deemed to be riding unsafely.

►The Coordinator, Track Representative, Track Day Instructors, the Safety and Medical teams are all officials and should be respected at all times. Disrespect to or abuse of officials will have stern consequences.

►Anyone not following the track discipline will be given 2 warnings. If these are ignored, the offender will receive a short-term ban from the circuit. Continued refusal to abide by the Rules will result in longer ban periods.

►Your bike is your responsibility. Ensure it is functioning properly in all respect. Attention should be given particularly to brakes, tires, fluids...etc. Any bike with leaking fluids will not be permitted on the circuit.
