

2018 RAMADAN CHALLENGE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS v3

DUBAI AUTODROME MOTOR SPORTS CLUB, PO Box 57331, Dubai, UAE will organise the 2018 Ramadan Challenge on the below dates;

Round 1 - 21st of May 2018
Round 2 - 28th of May 2018
Round 3 - 4th of June 2018
Round 4 - 11th of June 2018

The Ramadan Challenge will be organized by the DAMC and will follow for all four rounds the **2018 Dubai Kartdrome Sodi World Series Sprint Races Sporting Regulations**.

Junior Cup, Senior Cup & Masters Rounds will be held at the Dubai Kartdrome Outdoor CIK Circuit, **1.204 kilometres**, Clockwise Direction.

The final text of the Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version, which will be used in the case of any dispute arising as to their interpretation. Heading in this document are for ease and reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

1. ENTRIES:

Early Bird Race Entries can be paid online www.dubaiautodrome.com or e-mail rowenaa@dubaiautodrome.com or can be paid at Outdoor Reception **10 days prior to Round 1.**

1.1 ENTRY CRITERIA

1.2 JUNIOR CUP: 7 years and above, up to a maximum age of 14 years old and must have done a minimum of 10 indoor arrive and drive sessions previously. In addition to this, drivers must weigh a minimum of **45kg** with safety equipment (driver, suit, gloves, boots & helmet) *Note Rib protectors, neck braces, insert seats and kart ballast are not considered part of the drivers weight during official weigh in, hence will not be accepted.

SENIOR CUP: Every entrant must be 15 years and over and weigh a minimum of 80kg.

MASTERS CATEGORY (OF SENIOR CUP): Every entrant must be 35 years old and over and weigh a minimum of 90kg. with safety equipment (driver, suit, gloves, boots & helmet) *Note Rib protectors, neck braces, insert seats and kart ballast are not considered part of the drivers weight during official weigh in, hence will not be accepted.

*NB: Each Senior & Master category entrants must have posted a minimum lap time of **1 min 15 seconds** on the outdoor circuit's International configuration, during any arrive and drive session, in order to be eligible to enter this race.

***Drivers can use the kart weight ballast provided to reach the minimum weight limit.**

1.3 PAYMENTS:

There is an 'early bird Entry fee' (for all four rounds & Early bird entries guarantee entry to all four rounds of the Ramadan Challenge)

Junior Cup Early Bird fee is AED 1680 per driver inc VAT

Senior Cup Early Bird fee is AED 1900 per driver inc VAT

The deadline for this promotion is the 10th of May 2018.

1.4 All entries received after the **11th of May** will be charged as follows:

Junior Cup AED 495 per round inc of 5% VAT

Senior Cup AED 595 per round inc of 5% VAT

1.5 Early bird payments are non transferable and no refund will be given if no show.

1.6 No refunds or credit against future races will be given on the individual entries, for late comers or no show.

1.7 **STARTERS:** The maximum number of entries permitted per Ramadan Challenge Round is: **34 x Seniors and 17 x Juniors**

1.8 **The OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD will be displayed:** Under the Canopy at the Outdoor Kartdrome

Time Schedule of Events: Timetable will be displayed on official Notice board and website.

2 FORMAT:

2.1 Junior Cup Format

Limited to **17** drivers entering

Sign on & kart draw

Driver Weighing

Practice & Qualifying – 8 minutes

Race 1 – 7 Laps (Drivers will start as per their official classified Qualifying result)

Race 2 – 8 Laps (Top 5 driver's from Race1 will have their start positions reversed)

Race 3 – 10 Laps (Top 10 driver's from Race2 will have their start positions reversed)

2.2 Using the Points table in **Regulation 4.1**, there will be points awarded to the Driver's finishing position from Races 1, 2 & 3. These will be calculated at the completion of Race 3 on the night, to determine the night's overall result, with the top three drivers being awarded at the podium.

3.0 Senior Cup & Masters Format:

Limited to **34** drivers entering

Practice & Qualifying – 8 minutes

Race 1 → 9 Laps (Drivers will start as per their official classified Qualifying result)

Race 2 → 10 Laps (Top 5 driver's from Race1 will have their start positions reversed)

Race 3 → 12 Laps (Top 24 driver's from Race2 will have their start positions reversed)

4.0: POINT SCORING:

4.1: The organisers will keep track of each competitor's finishing results during the races, using the point system shown below. These points will be awarded for each heat and added together. The highest total will determine the Outright Winner of the Day.

4.2: Tie on Points:

Should there be competitors drawn on equal points, then the winner will be decided by the number of higher finishing's in either of the races. In the event there is still a draw, it will be decided as per the higher finishing in official Qualifying.

4.3: SWS World Ranking Points: The Ramadan Challenge will count towards the SWS World Rankings and those drivers registered with the SWS World Series, their points will be allocated as per the point scoring system defined by the SodiWSeries regulations.

**For both Junior Cup and Senior Sprint Cup: two sets of SWS points will be forwarded to the official SWS Championship, as per the official classified result from Race 1. The second set of SWS Points will be the overall ranking of the day.*

4.4: Ramadan Championship Points: Each Ramadan Challenge competitor will score “Ramadan Championship Points”, to determine the overall Championship Ranking after 4 rounds. These points are listed in **SR. 4.5**

4.6 There will be an additional **Ramadan Championship points** for the driver setting **Pole Position** during Qualifying and the **Fastest Lap** on the night, for both Junior Cup and Seniors, in all four Rounds.

5.0 MASTERS CATEGORY (OF SENIOR CUP)

- 5.1:** Any driver wishing to register and compete within the Masters category must be 35 years of age or older.
- 5.2:** There will be award presentations given to the top three scoring Masters at each round.
- 5.3:** The top 3 Masters will be selected from the overall classifications after the finals, where the highest placed masters on the night will be declared winners.
- 5.4** Kindly note - SWS World Rankings do not operate a Masters Category, so any points you get will be based on your overall ranking from Senior. Masters category is solely a Dubai Autodrome concept.

6.0: PRIZES:

6.1 JUNIOR CUP RAMADAN CHAMPION

- Winner will get 300 AED DA Voucher

HIGHEST PLACED JUNIOR DRIVER, WHO'S NEVER HELD A COMPETITION LICENSE BEFORE

will receive, courtesy of ENERGY Karts, one fully funded race meeting, within the UAE RMC or IAME X30 Championships. ENERGY karts will provide technical support for the practice day and during the race, 1 x ENERGY Micro Max, Mini Max or IAME Cadet Kart, plus a new set of tyres for race day. The driver is responsible for:

- Ensuring he passes his ARKS test and is holding a valid UAE ATC Competition License so he can participate
- Paying the relevant championship memberships, practice and entry fees
- Any crash damage

6.1.1 Complimentary ARKS test from Dubai Kartdrome to be used within 6 months

6.2 SECOND HIGHEST PLACED DRIVER, (EXCLUDING THE CHAMPIONSHIP WINNER), WHO'S NEVER RACED IAME X30 BEFORE):

The highest placed driver after the Ramadan Junior winner, who has never raced IAME X30 before, will receive, courtesy of IAME X30 Challenge, one fully funded race meeting, within the UAE IAME X30 Championships. IAME X30 will provide 'basic' technical support for the practice day and during the race, 1 x IAME Cadet. The driver is responsible for:

- Ensuring he has a valid UAE ATC Competition License so he can participate
- Paying the relevant championship memberships, practice and entry fees
- Buying New tyres for race day
- Any crash damage

6.2.1 Complimentary ARKS test from Dubai Kartdrome to be used within 6 months

6.3.1 All of the Top 15 Juniors in the Ramadan Championship will receive a FREE test/practice day with IAME Racing Engines

6.3.2 Junior Cup Driver's finishing: 1st, 2nd & 3rd will receive each a voucher for a "Discover SCUBA" course SUN DIVERS LLC Divecenter in Umm Al Quwain + a dry fit SunDivers T Shirt

6.4 SENIOR CUP Prizes:

The outright Senior Ramadan Challenge Champion will receive, courtesy of BRAND RACING, one kart to use during a one day race meeting, within the UAE RMC. BRAND Racing will provide one chassis, one Rotax engine, tent space, tent facilities and fuel/lubricants for the race. Items not included that will be driver's responsibility:

- Mechanical or technical assistance.
- Driver must have a valid UAE ATC Competition License to participate.
- Paying the relevant championship memberships, practice and entry fees.
- Buying new tyres for race day.
- Any crash damage.
- This prize can not be used for Dubai O Plate or RMC Round at Yas Marina.

6.4.1 Runner up receives a Dubai Autodrome Voucher worth AED 300.

6.4.2 Third Place will receive a Dubai Polo Shirt.

6.4.3 SENIOR Driver's finishing: 1st, 2nd & 3rd will receive each a voucher for a "OPEN Water Dive Course" from SUN DIVERS LLC + a dry fit SunDivers T Shirt

6.4.4 All of the Top 20 seniors in the Ramadan Championship will receive a FREE test/practice day with IAME Racing Engines

6.5 MASTER CUP Prizes:

6.5.1 Master Winner receives a Formula DXB Single Seater Experience.

6.5.2 Masters Driver's finishing: 1st, 2nd & 3rd will receive each a voucher for a "OPEN Water Dive Course" from SUN DIVERS LLC + a dry fit SunDivers T Shirt

6.6 TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PRIZES :

6.6.1 Should any prize winner entitled to the mentioned prizes in SR 6.1, SR 6.2 and SR 6.4, but does not wish to utilize them, they are to inform Dubai Autodrome Management, who will award the said prize to the next highest competitor.
