7. Scrutineering & Administrative Checks

- **7.1.** All vehicles must comply with the definitions as set out in the rules and regulations.
- **7.2.** For the scrutineering:
 - (a) All cars must be equipped with transponders.
 - (b) All start numbers must be affixed on the cars.
 - (c) All cars must have front and rear lights in working condition.
 - (d) All driver safety equipment must be made available for inspection.
- **7.3.** Only drivers and vehicles that have passed the Administrative Check (Sign-on and License check) and scrutineering have the right to participate in the event.

8. Insurance

- **8.1.** All competitors are insured in respect of Third Party Public liability insurance during the event.
- **8.2.** Competitors are advised to make own arrangements with regards to personal accidental injury cover and cover for damage to their vehicles and those of other competitors taking part.

9. Start position

- **9.1.** As set out in the rules and regulations.
- **9.2.** The starting procedure will be advised during the mandatory drivers briefing.

10. Results and protests

- **10.1.** Results will be published after each session for each class.
- **10.2.** Any protests should be made in accordance with the rules and regulations. The National Protest Fee is AED 1,500 and National Appeal Fee is AED 5,000.

11. SCRUTINEERING AND SPORTING CHECKS

- **11.1.** The following documents must be submitted to the secretary of the meeting by each competitor during initial sign-on:
 - (a) Competitor's race licence and any related documents
 - (b) Parent ASN authorization for foreign licence holders
 - (c) Entrant licence, if registered for team championship
- **11.2.** During initial scrutineering, and at any time during the event, each competitor must have the car's technical passport available. Initial scrutineering will take place in the garage assigned to each competitor.
- **11.3.** Race numbers and any official advertising must be on the car for inspection during scrutineering.
- **11.4.** Unless a waiver is granted by the stewards, competitors who do not keep to time limits will not be allowed to take part in the Event.
- **11.5.** Any car which, after being passed by the scrutineers, is dismantled or modified in a way which might affect its safety or call into question its eligibility, or which is involved in an accident with similar consequences, must be re-presented for scrutineering approval.
- **11.6.** The clerk of the course may require that any car involved in an accident be stopped and checked.
