<b>Rationale</b> :	In accordance with Article 16.3. of the Technical Regulations of the NGK UAE ProCar Championship 2021-22 and on request of the majority of competitors competing in the newly formed Clio Cup Class for Renault Clio Cup Gen 5 cars, controlled tyres will be specified for this class.	
Action:	Change to Article 16.1. of NGK UAE ProCar Technical Regulations Tyre choice is free in all classes, except CLIO CUP CLASS in which Cooper Tires slick tyres (compound A30) supplied by Sodipneu UAE are mandatory. [AMENDED]

Rationale:	On request of the majority of competitors competing in the newly formed Clio Cup Class for Renault Clio Cup Gen 5 cars, a tyre limitation per event will be introduced.	
Action:	Change to Article 26 of NGK UAE ProCar Sporting Regulations	
	<ul> <li>26.1. In all classes except for CLIO CUP CLASS, there shall be no limitation on the number of tyres permitted to be used during an event [AMENDED]</li> <li>26.2. In CLIO CUP CLASS, a maximum of four new tyres may be used per event. For clarity, an event is deemed to include the following sessions: <ul> <li>a. Qualifying</li> <li>b. Races</li> </ul> </li> <li>There is no limitation on tyres which can be used during open pitlane testing, or exclusive test sessions on the day preceding the event or during the warm-up session. [ADDED]</li> </ul>
