

Dubai Kartdrome Endurance Championship
SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS
Round 1 – 26th - 27th of February 2022 V1

THE DUBAI AUTODROME MOTOR SPORTS CLUB (DAMC), Dubai Autodrome, PO Box 57331, Dubai, UAE will organize the **Dubai Kartdrome Endurance Championship RD1 – Dubai 700km Endurance**. This race meeting is for leisure karts and will be organized for the Leisure Karting Championship using a temporary karting circuit on the Dubai Autodrome Circuit on **Saturday 26th & Sunday 27th of February 2022**.

PROGRAMME & TIMINGS: Provisional timings can be found on the website (<https://www.dubaiautodrome.ae>).

The meeting will be held under the present General Regulations for the **Dubai Kartdrome Endurance Championship 2022** and these Supplementary Regulations. The Organizers may issue bulletins throughout the event that will be posted on the Bulletin Board.

DIRECTION & LENGTH OF CIRCUIT: REVERSE WITH HILL - Approx 1.25 km (Anti-Clockwise)

ENTRIES: Late entry will be granted until **Friday, 25th of February, before 4pm. Maximum of 44 teams.**

Any officials of the Endurance Championship present or that have supported the event over the past 5 years from the date of this event may not represent or assist any team during the course of the event. The clerk of the course may disqualify any team doing so.

ELIGIBLE TEAMS & COMPETITORS: All teams and competitors must have completed all entry forms, paid in full and submitted all driver data and weighed-in at the specified time slot on **Saturday 26th of February 2022** to compete in the race. Dispensation will only be given for drivers flying in from overseas or agreed with the organizers in advance with email confirmation from David Bright. **A penalty of AED 210 still applies for a no-show during the allocated drivers weigh-in on Saturday 26th of February 2022.**

ENTRY DEFINITIONS:

- (i) All Drivers, Team Members and Spectators must Present Proof of complete vaccination (event date minimum 14 days since the last injection, checked through Al Hosn App / DHA App). For attendees coming from other countries: a government-approved vaccination proof/card is required.
- (ii) OR have undergone one Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) Test by an approved test provider maximum 72 hours before arriving at the Venue and provide a negative test result (checked through Al Hosn App or print out of Negative PCR results from Authorized PCR testing Centre).

ACCEPTANCE / REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: Team entries will only be final once 100% payment is completed. If a team or team member has not paid or commits any unsporting like behavior towards other teams or the organizers in the lead up to or on the day of the race, the organizers have the right to refuse entry to the race to the team or individual. Late entries might be accepted and but will be subject to approval of the organizers. Late entry team information will not be included in the Official Program.

DRIVERS' BRIEFING: Drivers briefing will be mandatory for all Drivers. Drivers will need to sign the attendance sheet when coming in. Non-compliance will either result in exclusion or AED 210 fine. **Team Captains are responsible for ensuring all the team's drivers are attending the briefing.** The team captain must liaise with the organizers if any of their drivers will be late or unable to attend the briefing. Only Written approval by David Bright will be accepted. This needs to be shown to the Clerk of the Course on arrival to the event.

Note: All Drivers & Team Captains will need to weigh in themselves, if they are driving in the event, before the Briefing.

BULLETIN BOARD: The official notice board and bulletins will be located in the reception canopy of the Outdoor Kartdrome.

EVENT FORMAT - As per Regulation 3.0 of the Dubai Kartdrome Endurance Championship. Round 1 of the Dubai Kartdrome Endurance Championship will run to **Format A**, which will be:

- Practice & Qualifying Combined: **60 minutes** (This determines your start position for the race)
- Endurance Race – **700km** (Approx. 12hrs)

FORCE MAJEUR – Due to any force majeure - the race duration will be extended up to MAXIMUM of **14 Hrs.**

START POSITIONS: As per the General Regulations, the start will be a Le Mans start with order according to the Official Classified results from the '**Combined Practice & Qualifying**'.

FLAGS: Flag signals will be given in accordance with the General Regulations of the Championship and with Appendix H of the present Code.

GENERAL REGULATIONS SPECIFICS: Below refers to specifics of the race not described in the General Regulations.

KART ROTATION – Regulation 9b: **5 kart Lanes** will be used for kart rotation during this Event

Driving Stint Duration – Regulation 9a:

- Driver Max Stint Time – Driver Max Stint Time – 90 minutes
- Minimum Rest time between stints – 45 minutes
- Minimum drive time per driver during the event -
 - 6 drivers on a team / each driver must drive minimum 1 hours
 - 4 – 5 drivers per team / each driver must drive minimum 2 hours
 - 3 drivers per team / each driver must drive minimum 3hrs
- **Mandatory Pit Stops - Regulation 9e:** – It will be mandatory for each team to do **16 pit stops**.
- **Technical Checks - Regulation 6:** – There will be no technical checks.
- **Pit Lane Closure Towards the End of The Race – Regulation 9g:**
Please be informed that PIT LANE WILL BE CLOSED once the leader will complete 535 laps.
This means driver-changes, mandatory pit stops, and fuel stops must be done before the leader completes 535 Laps. Drivers/Teams can only enter the Pit Lane if they have Technical Problems.

PIT TIME - Regulation 9d: The minimum Pit Time Duration will be **3 minutes 30 seconds**.

WEIGHT LAP BONUS - Regulation 13b: To compensate for heavy drivers, the Organizer will credit laps to the teams with an average weight over **85kgs**. Teams falling under the bonus under the Bonus Group's shown below will be credited laps in the race.

90 kgs up to 95 kg	Bonus Group 1	:	1 Lap will be credited
95+ kg up to 100 kg	Bonus Group 2	:	2 Lap will be credited
100 kg +	Bonus Group 3	:	4 Lap will be credited

This procedure will only start after **50%** of the race distance has been completed and teams benefiting will be listed in a Bulletin, which will be posted onto the Official Notice Board.

***Weight Lap Bonuses are based on driver's weight plus race gear at the beginning of the event and must be maintained throughout the event at weight checks.**

***Should any driver retire from the race and their minimum drive time has not been met, the teams Bonus Laps will be recalculated and adjusted by the time keepers.**

MINIMUM WEIGHT LIMIT – Regulation 13 - Drivers who fall below the minimum weight of 85kg will only have to carry a maximum of 30kg in their kart's weight box. EG: If a driver weighs 45-50kg, including all their safety gear, on the grounds of safety, the driver will only have to add a maximum of 30kg of weight ballast to the kart.

HELMET VISOR: Clear & Yellow Visors only permitted from 18:00hrs onwards on **February 26th**.

RESULTS: Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each race.

PIT ITEMS: Available only at the allocated timeslot on **Saturday, 27th of February 2022 (refer to official timetable)**

DRIVERS ARM BANDS: The organizer hereby informs all the teams that a AED 210 deposit will be charged and will be payable at the registration desk. The AED 210 deposit shall be refunded upon return of all arm bands issued to the teams. Lost armbands will be charged at AED 30 per piece.

HELMETS

Moto-cross / off-road helmets like shown below, are not permitted at Dubai Kartdrome:



SAFETY CAR (Reg. 10 d): During the full course yellow, the Pit exit will remain closed when the Safety Car and karts cross the **START FINISH LINE** and the Pit Exit will open when the Safety Car and karts cross **TURN 4**.

COVID MEASURES –

All Drivers, Team Members and Spectators attending the event must read and comply to the Dubai Autodrome COVID 19 Guidelines for National Events held at Dubai Kartdrome.

All persons must always wear a face mask and practice social distancing when in the pit garages, inside the green fence confines of the Kartdrome, including the viewing terrace. Teams are responsible for their guests and team personnel at all times. Repeat offenders will be issued a 10 second penalty, to be served inside the penalty box.

A face mask is not required WHEN driving. However, the driver needs to wear a face mask when walking to or from the Driver Change area. (Drivers can also leave their helmet on)

NATIONAL CODE OF CONDUCT:

In entering any motorsport event in the UAE, sanctioned by the Emirates Motorsport Organization, all Participants (Competitors, Entrants, Parents, Guardians, Team Principals and their Personnel, Family Members, Driver Coach or any other person associated with the Competitor) implicitly agree to be governed by the EMSO Code of Conduct and accept it unconditionally.
